The Zoo Snooze will start with a pizza dinner and include an animal ambassador presentation/games and learning activities followed by a night hike around the zoo before lights out around 10:30 PM.

The group will then spend a few hours walking around the zoo and visiting the animal enclosures/habitats before receiving a box meal prior to boarding the bus to head back home.
